# **Alabama Legislation**

Alabama Senate Bill 83 was introduced January 9, by Sen. Gerald Dial. The Alabama Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Patient Safety Act would establish consistent education and certification standards for the state's medical imaging and radiation therapy personnel.

S.B.83 has been referred to the Senate Health and Human Services Committee for consideration. Senator Dial, a seventerm member of the Alabama Senate from Lineville, is a member of the committee.

Passage of S.B.83 will maximize patient safety, decrease health care costs and help provide a more timely and accurate diagnosis. Over 5,000 R.Ts reside in the state. It is time these professionals are recognized and their voice is heard.
